

Additional First Aid Treatment Permission

The volunteers running the first aid station need permission to administer over the counter medications for the following conditions.

NOTE: every attempt will be made to provide sugar free medications for students with diabetic conditions.

Heat related stress: Electrolytes – sport drink powders, salt tablets in extreme circumstances, Solarcaine spray and gel for sunburn, sunscreen.

Muscle strains: Ben-gay, Icy Hot, topical analgesics such as Aspercream.

Digestive tract problems: Nauzene (cannot be used with diabetics), Antacid tablets (check for interaction with your students prescription drugs), Immodium – loperamide hydrochloride, Gas relief tablets.

Insect bite/sting reactions: Benzocane spray – Sting kill, Benadryl, topical hydrocortisone, insect repellent.

Rashes: Topical hydrocortisone, topical calimine lotion.

Wound infection (existing and preventative): Topical antibiotics such as triple antibiotic ointment and Bacitracin.

Foreign objects in the eye: eye flush aids, Visine.

Sore throat / Cold: throat spray, Chloraseptic lozenges, Tylenol.
